Assurance Measures & Survey Results

Each year the Division determines measures for the outcomes and strategies within our Education Plan. Satisfaction surveys are one tool utilized to gather data for these measures, and during the 2023-2024 school year, the Division participated in two rounds of surveys of our students, parents, and staff. Highlights included:

- The Division saw increases in 11 of 12 overall Alberta Education Assurance Measures, compared to the previous year, with the final measure within 1% of the previous year's result.
- The Division saw increases in all 12 parent Alberta Education Assurance Measures, compared to the previous year.
- The Division was at, or above, the provincial average in 10 of 12 Alberta Education
- Assurance Measures.
- The Division remained the same, or improved upon, in 28 of 33 Red Deer Public Schools' parent, student, and staff satisfaction measures, compared to the previous year. <u>RESULTS</u>
